

2b. Create a Pie Graph

This PICNIC shows you how to create a pie graph for data in a specific field.

Steps

1. Ensure that an iVIEW Index is created and active. See the iVIEW, 2a – Create an Index Picnic.
2. In Table View, click on the **iVIEW** tab (in the upper right corner), then click the gear icon.
3. Click the **Pie Graph** icon.
4. Choose the field you want to graph from the list.
5. Click **Go**.
