



## 6b. Link to Text in an Image or Native File

This PICNIC shows you how to link comments in a Comment Set to text in a native file or to an annotation on an image. Comments make it easy to communicate key document information with others on your team.

### Steps

1. In Document View, click the Comments tab and if necessary, select the Comment Set.
2. Select the item you want to associate the comment to and type the comment.
3. Click **Post**. The comment updates, displaying a link icon, which tells you the comment is linked to text or an annotation.

<h3>Native Files</h3>		<h3>Notes</h3> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ For native files, select the text you want to link the comment to, create the comment and click Post.</li> <li>➤ When you select the posted comment, the text linked to the comment will automatically be highlighted.</li> </ul>
<h3>Annotations on Images</h3>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ For images, create an annotation. Then select the annotation so that a dashed line appears around it. Create the comment and click Post.</li> <li>➤ When you select the posted comment, a dashed line appears around the annotation.</li> </ul>
